The intention of the uniform policy is to promote equality, pride and responsibility in our students in preparation for adult life. It should ensure equal opportunities without highlighting specific fashion trends and promoting inclusion of all students.

## Compulsory Items

- **Blazer and / or School Jumper**  
Black blazer and /or Black school jumper with the school logo, purchased from Castle Sports & Uniform Ltd  
Blazer / Jumper to be worn at all times.  
Exceptions:
  1. During break/lunch when engaging in physical sporting activity.
  2. During clearly indicated 'summer uniform season' - Summer Term 2 - the May half-term until the end of the summer term mark the 'summer uniform season' when the blazers/jumpers do not need to be worn due to the potential heat.
- **Shirt** Plain white school short sleeve or long sleeve shirt.  
The shirt should be worn always tucked in to support a smart appearance.
- **Tie** The Falmouth School tie, purchased from Castle Sports & Uniform Ltd
- **Skirt** plain black formal pleated skirt or formal black skirt (No Lycra, No Denim)  
  
or
- **Trousers** plain black formal trousers of smart appearance, full length, (No Denim, No Chinos)
- **Socks** plain formal black socks only, no logos or stripes (not sports socks)
- **Tights** plain black tights

## Footwear

- Plain black shoes
- Low heeled shoes with black soles
- Covered toe shoes
- No visible logos or shoes that are easily identifiable as branded
- Not permitted: sports trainers, coloured laces, boots, shoes with high heels, deck shoes, sandals, mules, flip flops, footwear reducing the foot protection by its lack of covering

**No high tops No vans/converse styles No ankle boots/boots No white/coloured branding**

### Optional Items

- **Shorts** Plain black formal school shorts (no denim or chino style material)
- Students can wear a plain black narrow belt with a plain buckle.
- **Outdoor Coat.** This should be a suitable waterproof or warm coat for the winter months. Students will be asked to remove it when entering all indoor spaces.
- **Outdoor garments,** such as gloves, hats and caps should not be worn indoors.

### **Nailwear /Makeup**

- Nail extensions are not permitted to be worn due to health and safety reasons. Students will be asked to remove it if worn.
- False eyelashes are not permitted to be worn. Students will be asked to remove.
- Makeup if worn should be subtle / natural

### **Hair**

- Hair must be one natural shade throughout.
- Hair should be worn in a conventional style.
- Extreme haircuts (e.g., shaved patterns, mohawks) or non-natural colours are not permitted.

## **Jewellery**

- Students may wear one pair of small, plain ear studs, e.g. one stud in each ear.
- Medical alert identity bracelets permitted for health reasons and emergencies.
- Nose piercings, including plastic retainers, are not permitted due to health and safety reasons; students will be asked to remove.
- Any other body piercings, including plastic retainers, are not permitted due to health and safety reasons.
- A watch is allowed.
