Year 11 and year 13 students are embarking on their exams season soon and structured revision has been taking place at a steady pace to support students every lesson, every day. After the holidays, the maths team will take the helm of the Mastery sessions to consolidate the key topics with all our students. We emphasise the importance of attending all the revision sessions on offer: students are fully supported and their time is effectively dedicated to navigate their preparation and rehearsals at this important time in their education.

As you are aware, revision sessions take place daily after school as well. We cannot emphasise enough how important it is for all the students to be with their subject teachers in their learning environment to access this invaluable support beyond the school day. Attendance at these carefully designed sessions will enable them to fit in their relaxation activities and have a clear direction on how to rehearse learning material impactfully beyond their classroom independently.

Where a student has been invited to their specific targeted support session, these continue running as per the invitations from individual subjects.



Sparx and Tassomai club runs every morning from 8.15am in the library. This enables the students to maintain that frequent and focused but proportionate retrieval practice.

Immersing into learning in the morning through a short and intensive activity creates a great cognitive stimulation that then inevitably enables the student to be a clear and effective thinker during their lessons from the outset. What a great way to start a school day!

Research related to frequent and sustained engagement with the Tassomai and Sparx learning platforms shows that it leads directly to an improvement in outcomes, including the exam results. We absolutely want our Falmouth School students to benefit from these accessible resources that are available to them every day. We kindly ask for your support to navigate your son/daughter towards these learning tools and encourage them to exceed their goals as they can make incremental gains and substantially benefit.

A number of revision sessions are taking place over the Easter holidays and we thank you for supporting your child attending these as much as possible. Whilst enjoying a well-earned rest, the structured and expertly prepared revision sessions on offer by dedicated teaching staff can greatly maximise self-assurance and further independent revision.

At Falmouth Sixth Form the level of interest for the pursuit of qualifications with us is substantially higher than last year. We envisage that many of our students will continue pursuing with us their next set of qualifications. Our students can continue embracing their love for learning with the expert teachers who know them really well already and who can smoothly build on their existing skills to further their skills and knowledge repertoire in the post-16 qualifications.
