If you do not have access to ParentPay, please contact the school as soon as possible so we can assist you.

The remaining balance can be paid in full or in instalments, but must be completed by Wednesday 2nd July 2025. Please note that we are only able to secure bookings with external providers once payment is received. Failure to keep up with payments may result in your child losing their place.








St. Mawes Castle
