Dear year 11 students and parents/carers,

Re: Year 11 Prom

I am thrilled to be in the position to write to confirm arrangements for our Year 11 Prom. We really hope that students will join us for what we hope will be a very special and memorable evening.

The chosen venue will be **Princess Pavilion Falmouth** with the prom itself taking place on **Friday 20th June**. Students are asked to arrive between **6.30-7.00pm**, at which time parents/carers are welcome to come into the gardens for photos and to soak up the atmosphere. Parking at the venue is limited, but students can walk up through Gyllyngdune Gardens from the seafront as an alternative drop-off zone. The evening will close at **10.30pm**. Collection will be from the rear car park (Melvill Road) only, as the gardens will be shut after dark. Should any student wish to leave the venue before 10.30pm, they will be allowed to do so, but they will not be permitted to re-enter the premises.

Whilst many students will undoubtedly choose to wear formal dinner attire, there is no obligation to do so. The evening is a celebration for our students, so as long as they are happy, that is fine by us. However, we do have a collection of dresses and suits for students to borrow, should they wish to do so. Students should speak to me if this is the case.

As you would hope, students will be expected to be ambassadors for our school, and comply with our behaviour expectations at all times. This means that it will be a strictly no smoking and no vaping venue and the bar will only serve non-alcoholic beverages to students. Mobile phones, however, are permitted, as I am sure that students will want to mark the occasion by taking lots of photos. Should a student arrive intoxicated or not adhere to our expectations at any point in the evening, parents will be contacted and expected to collect their child immediately. Staff will be on duty during the evening to help students to have a safe and enjoyable evening.

We really hope that your child will celebrate with us. Tickets will cost £30 and will be non-refundable. We have sole hire of the venue and food will be covered, as will a DJ and photobooth, by the cost of the ticket. Non-alcoholic drinks will be served at a small cost to students.
