Falmouth School Activities Week

Welcome to the activities information for Falmouth School's Activities Week (AW).

The week has been designed to enable students to have fun and learn outside the curriculum, giving students the opportunity to choose an exciting activity and participate in things they may never have done before. It is a highlight of the year where students get to learn, build confidence, make new friends and enjoy themselves.

Choosing the activity:

There are a range of activities this year, providing an opportunity for all to take part. Please go through the information in the booklet of activities on offer and decide on your activity choice for the week.

How to apply for your Activities Week 2024 :

On-line booking for the activities on offer in AW will be open on ParentPay account on **WEDNESDAY 17th APRIL 2024 at 4.30 pm**

Activities are allocated on a first come, first served basis and if the activity is oversubscribed, you will need to select from the alternative activities on offer.

Activity Prices:

- **£0- £30:** To be paid for in full when the place is chosen
- **£30 - £100:** A non-refundable deposit of £30 is required, once the place is chosen and then payment will be required in instalments by a preset date.
- **£100 and above:** A non-refundable deposit of £30 is needed once the place is chosen and then payment will be required in instalments by preset dates

Paying for the Activity:

Payments for activities will be via the ParentPay system. You will select your activity and pay your activity cost (full, if below £30) or the deposit required to secure your placement. Simply log on and pay your deposit once bookings are opened on **Wednesday 17th April 2024 at 4.30 pm**

The deposit amount will be confirmed on selection off activity. This will be required to secure the place on the chosen activity.

If you do not have access to ParentPay please contact the school at your earliest convenience.

Further Payment

You can continue to pay the outstanding remainder of the balance in instalments or in full thereafter by **31st May 2024**

Failure to keep up with the payments could result in your child's place being removed from the activity as we need these payments to secure places with external bookings agents. If you have any queries please contact enquiries@falmouthschool.net

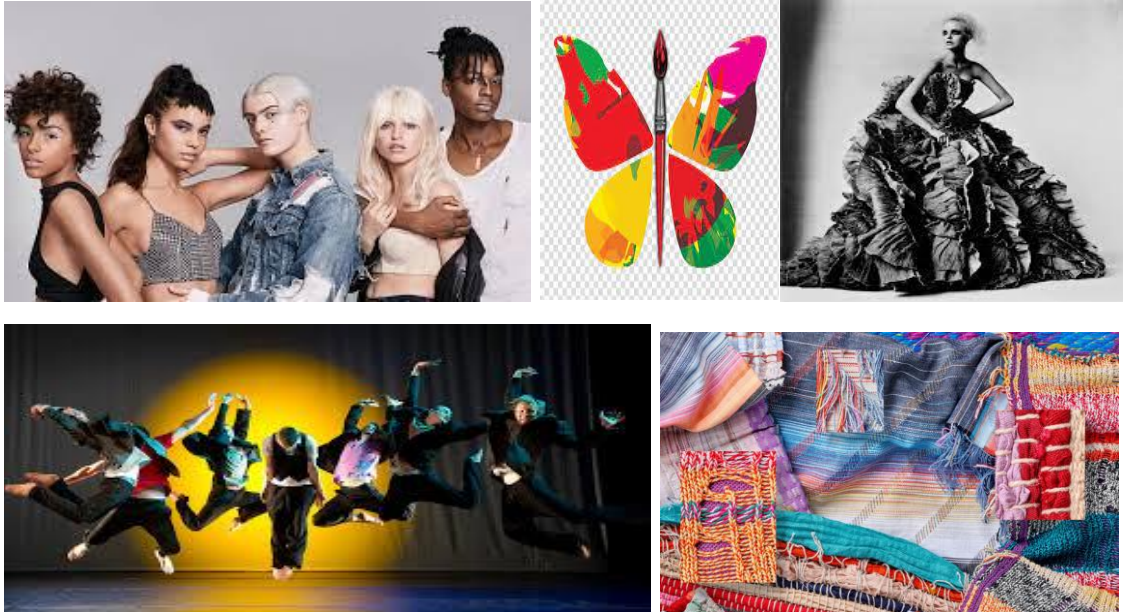
We will draw and document through photo safari to inform our practical work to include pottery and sculpture, land art, printmaking, painting/ spray painting.

Love Films?

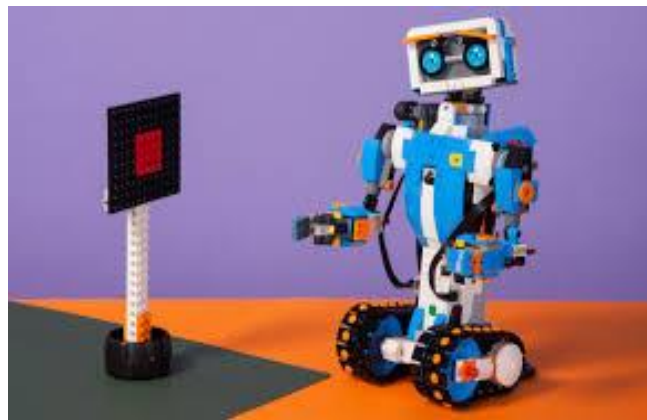
Spend a week with practitioners learning about the industry from scripts, watching films and behind the scenes with light, camera, action!
