- A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the activity cost is required at the time of booking to secure your child's place.
- The remaining balance must be paid in full by Wednesday 2nd July 2025.
- Payments are to be made through the ParentPay system. You can pay the deposit or full amount once bookings open.

If you do not have access to ParentPay, please contact the school as soon as possible so we can assist you.

Please note that failure to keep up with payments may result in your child losing their place, as we need to confirm bookings with external providers.

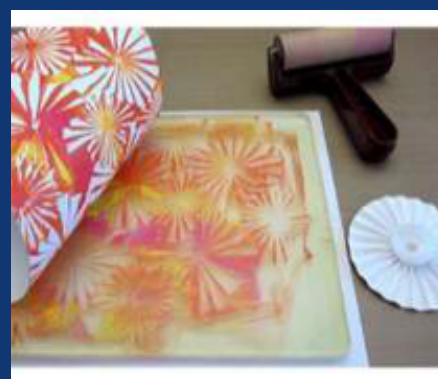
ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS

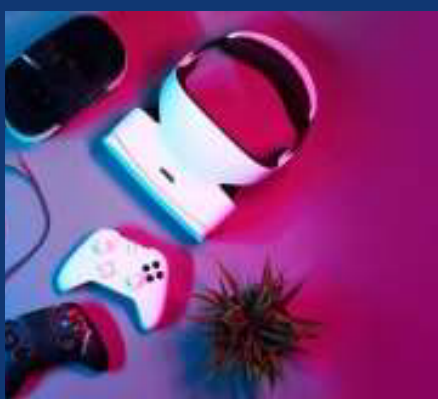


Games Masters
